Insurance and Indemnity

I understand that hockey can be a dangerous sport and the risk of injury whilst playing or training is high. I agree that it is my responsibility to arrange and take medical or other insurance necessary to cover any such injury to my child and that WHC and WTI will not necessarily have any insurance on behalf of its members to cover such claims. I agree to indemnify WHC and WTI, their Committees, coaches or other authorised representatives against any claims for injury, expenses or damages suffered by my child, except as a result of the wilful negligence of that party. Should any injury occur I understand that a reasonable effort will be made to contact me immediately. When contact cannot be made, I give permission for my child to receive medical/dental attention and agree to meet any expenses incurred.

I also agree to procure my child to play in a safe manner according to the rules of the game and to follow instructions from coaches, captains and officials. If my child breaches these conditions, I understand he or she may be liable to sanctions imposed by WHC and WTI, and Hockey WA.

Medical Conditions

I acknowledge that it is my responsibility to advise the coaching staff of the Club of any medical condition which may influence my child's participation in hockey activities, or which may influence any medical attention which may be required whilst involved in those activities.

Umpiring Duties

I understand that if my child is playing in a senior team he or she is to be available for umpiring duties as required by the Club. Umpiring duties generally coincide with team byes and the Club's umpiring coordinator allocates all appointments. Some club members may undertake umpiring duties on your child's behalf for a fee – see the umpiring coordinator for details. Non-attendance attracts large fines from Hockey WA and I understand this cost is passed on to the nominated players who don't turn up for umpiring duties or who fail to find a suitable replacement. Year 9/10 and 11/12 players are strongly encouraged to participate in umpiring training to further enhance umpiring skills and confidence.

Working With Children Checks

Our Club requires all volunteers in contact with children, such as coaches and team managers, to obtain Working With Children Checks. If you are to be involved in the Club's junior program, a Check will be obtained for you at the Club's expense.
